FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION FOR SEPTIC REPAIR/REPLACEMENT AND WATER/SEWER CONNECTIONS

Financial aid may be available to homeowners who are repairing or replacing their household sewage treatment system or to those connecting to water or sewer lines.

Hamilton County Community Development Program

This is a grant program, based on family income.

- Maximum grant will be \$6,500.
- Limited to water tap and sewage treatment system costs only.
- Areas not covered under this program: Amberley Village, Indian Hill, Terrace Park, Newtown, Madeira, Evendale, Mariemont and Milford.

Payment will be issued after the installation is approved by Hamilton County Public Health.

- Grant and loan programs are based on family income.
- Limited to sewage treatment system costs only.
- Areas not covered under this program: Amberley Village, Indian Hill, Terrace Park, Newtown, Madeira, Evendale, Mariemont and Milford

U.S. Department of Agriculture – Rural Development

- This is a loan or grant program.
- Grant is based on family income and applicants must be over 62 years of age.
- Moneys can be used for sewage treatment systems and sewer tap fees or other home repairs.
- Areas covered under this program: Harrison, Harrison Township, Crosby Township, Whitewater Township or any property owner west of the Great Miami River

Payment will be issued after the installation is approved by Hamilton County Public Health.

Hamilton County Home Improvement Program (HIP)

- This is a bank loan at an interest rate 3% below normal.
- Loans may be used for septic systems, water/sewer connections and many other home improvements.
- No income restrictions for eligibility, but must meet bank's credit requirements.
- Can be used to correct code violations.
- Areas not covered under this program: Arlington Heights and Milford
