H1N1 VACCINATION CLINICS SCHEDULED *Must have appointment to attend*

HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO – Hamilton County Public Health scheduled vaccination clinics for specific groups that are at high risk of serious complications from H1N1 flu.

Tuesday, November 17: Only for pregnant women and adults or parents who live with or care for children younger than 6 months of age.

Time: 4 – 6 p.m.

Location: Job and Family Services building at 184 East McMillan Street in Corryville.

Thursday, November 19: Only for children 6 months through 4 years of age.

Time: 4 – 6 p.m.

Location: HC ESC building at 924 Waycross Road in Forest Park.

Individuals must have an appointment to attend. To receive an appointment, send an e-mail to H1N1appointment@hamilton-co.org. Include the date of the clinic in the subject line and the high risk category in the e-mail.

Appointment-only clinics will serve those most at risk for hospitalization from flu which includes:

- Pregnant women
- People who live with or care for children younger than 6 months of age
- Children 6 months through 4 years of age
- Children 5 through 18 years of age who have a chronic medical condition

There will be additional vaccination clinics scheduled each week as vaccine supply permits. Individuals part of a high risk group that is not being served by one of the current clinics should check www.hamiltoncountyhealth.org for clinic announcements.

Documentation that individuals are in the priority group must be provided. This may include: prescription, medicine bottle, appointment card, birth certificate, hospital discharge summary or another form of proof.
