Regulation 1 - 2008 adopting and/or revising Sewage Treatment System (STS) fees pursuant to Ohio Revised Code (ORC), Sections 3709.09 and 3709.21

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District has the authority pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3709.09 and Section 3709.21 to establish a uniform system of fees for services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District is mandated to provide services that protect the public health and prevent disease; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District has determined it necessary to adopt and/or revise fees in order to cover costs of programs to protect public health; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District has determined it necessary to adopt and/or revise the Sewage Treatment System (STS) fees; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District hereby adopts and/or revises the following Sewage Treatment System (STS) fees to become effective August 1, 2008.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District hereby finds by a vote of at least three-fourths of its members that this regulation be read only once, and the requirement that it be read on three different days be dispensed with as provided by law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by this Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District, that this regulation be published in one newspaper of general circulation within the Hamilton County General Health District once a week for two consecutive weeks and that the first publication take place no later than ten (10) days prior to the effective date of the Regulation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District find and determine that all formal actions relative to the passage of this regulation were taken in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirement, including Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
