3. Proposed Vending and Mobile Food Service Fees Presentation

Assistant Health Commissioner Greg Kesterman reviewed the Mobile and Vending Fee Changes PowerPoint. Mr. Kesterman covered the comprehensive cost methodology that was completed. With nearly 3,000 licenses issued annually, HCPH fees are among the lowest in the State.

In 2018, 294 mobile food licenses were issued with most operators inspected at our office. License is required to be purchased from location were unit is headquartered, but they can sell anywhere in Ohio. In 2018, 149 vending locations were licensed. Fees are capped by previous year's CPI licensing and soda and chip machines are not licensed. Current and proposed fees compared to other counties were discussed. HCPH has received no written or verbal comments to date on the proposed fee changes.
