## HAMILTON COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH COMPLETES ANNUAL REORGANIZATION

**HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO** – Hamilton County Board of Health completed its annual reorganization, electing Tracey A. Puthoff, Esq. of Anderson Township as president of the board and electing Mark Rippe, Indian Hill as vice president.

Board member Kenneth Amend, M.D., of Green Township, was reappointed by the Hamilton County District Advisory Council. The District Advisory Council is made up of presidents of the township boards of trustees, village mayors and the president of the Board of County Commissioners.

The five-member Board of Health is the governing body of Hamilton County Public Health. In addition to Puthoff, Rippe and Dr. Amend, board members include Thomas Chatham of Green Township and Jim Brett of Whitewater Township. The Board has the authority to adopt public health rules and regulations, which have the same status as law, and to enact policies within Hamilton County Public Health's jurisdiction.

The Board of Health's regular meeting schedule through March 2016 will be on the second Monday of each month at 6:30 p.m. at Hamilton County Public Health, 250 William Howard Taft, in Corryville. All meetings are open to the public.
