

REGULATION 3-2023

REGULATION ADOPTING REVISED LOCAL FEES FOR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKS, RECREATION CAMPS, COMBINED AND TEMPORARY PARK-CAMPS, AND RESIDENT CAMPS.

The Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District met in regular session on September 11, 2023 with the following members present:

_____ moved for adoption of the following regulation:

Regulation 3-2023, Adopting Revised Local Fees Pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code 3709.09, 3709.21, 3729.05 and 3729.07 for recreational vehicle parks, recreation camps, combined and temporary park-camps, and resident camps.

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District has the authority pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 3709.09, 3709.21, and 3729.07 to establish a uniform system of fee services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District is mandated to provide services that protect the public health and prevent disease; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District has determined it is necessary to revise the local license fees for recreational vehicle parks, recreation camps, combined and temporary park-camps, and resident camps pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 3729 and Ohio Administrative Code 3701-25 and 3701-26; and

WHEREAS, any entity that would be affected by the revision to the fees for recreational vehicle parks, recreation camps, combined and temporary park-camps, and resident camps were advised by the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District at least twenty (20) days prior to the September 11, 2023 hearing; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District hereby adopts Regulation 3-2023, revising the local fee schedule as

follows for all recreational vehicle parks, recreation camps, combined and temporary park-camps, and resident camps, effective January 1, 2024:

Recreational vehicle parks, recreation camps, combined and temporary park-camps, and resident camps with 50 or fewer sites	\$222.00
Recreational vehicle parks, recreation camps, combined and temporary park-camps with more than 50 sites	\$4.25 per each additional site
Temporary park-camps with 50 or fewer sites	\$268.00
Temporary park-camps with more than 50 sites	\$5.00 per each additional site

State Fees In addition to the local fee for a license, a state fee portion, pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code, will be added, as applicable.

Late Fees If a payment of a fee is not received by the day on which payment is due, the board of health shall assess a penalty pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District hereby finds by a vote of at least three-fourths of its members that this regulation be read only once and the requirement that it be read on three different days be dispensed with as provided by law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any previous regulation, rule, or policy adopted by the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District, that in any way conflicts with this regulation in part or in whole, is hereby rescinded and repealed in part or in whole to the extent of any conflict; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District, that this regulation be published in one newspaper of general circulation within the Hamilton County General Health District once a week for two consecutive weeks and that the first publication take place no later than ten (10) days prior to the effective date of the Regulation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District find and determine that all formal actions relative to the passage of this regulation were taken in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirement, including s 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
