

REGULATION 2-2007

ADOPTING AND/OR REVISING SEWAGE TREATMENT SYSTEM (STS) FEES FOR APPLICATION TO CONSTRUCT OR REPLACE AN STS, PERMIT TO INSTALL(PTI) AN STS, SUBDIVISION REVIEW/LOT EVALUATIONS , ADDITIONS, INSTALLATION REINSPECTION FEES, SEWAGE TRUCK INSPECTIONS, STS INSTALLER REGISTRATION, STS SERVICE PROVIDER REGISTRATION, STS SEPTAGE HAULER REGISTRATION, STS VARIANCES, STS ALTERATION PERMIT, UNAUTHORIZED WORK (FAILURE TO OBTAIN A PTI PRIOR TO DOING WORK), UNAUTHORIZED WORK (FAILURE TO OBTAIN AN ALTERATION PERMIT PRIOR TO DOING WORK), AND UNAUTHORIZED WORK (FAILURE TO OBTAIN AN APPLICATION TO CONSTRUCT OR REPLACE AN STS PRIOR TO DOING WORK).

Mr. Brett moved for adoption of the following regulation:

Regulation 2-2007 adopting and/or revising Sewage Treatment System STS fees pursuant to Ohio Revised Code (ORC), Sections 3709.09, 3718.06, and 3709.21 for Application to Construct or Replace an STS, Permit to Install(PTI) an STS, Subdivision Review/Lot Evaluations, Additions, Installation Reinspection Fees, Sewage Truck Inspections, STS Installer Registration, STS Service Provider Registration, STS Septage Hauler Registration, STS Variances, STS Alteration Permit, and Unauthorized Work (Failure to obtain a PTI prior to doing work), Unauthorized Work (Failure to obtain an Alteration Permit prior to doing work), and Unauthorized Work (Failure to obtain an Application to Construct or Replace a STS prior to doing work).

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District has the authority pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3709.09, Section 3718.06, and Section 3709.21 to establish a uniform system of fees for services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District is mandated to provide services that protect the public health and prevent disease; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District has determined it necessary to adopt and or revise fees in order to cover costs of programs to protect public health; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District has determined it is necessary to adopt and/or revise the Sewage Treatment System (STS) fees for **Application to Construct or Replace an STS, Permit to Install(PTI) an STS, Subdivision Review/Lot Evaluations, Additions,**



Installation Reinspection Fees, Sewage Truck Inspections, STS Installer Registration, STS Service Provider Registration, STS Septage Hauler Registration, STS Variances, STS Alteration Permit, and Unauthorized Work (Failure to obtain a PTI prior to doing work), Unauthorized Work (Failure to obtain an Alteration Permit prior to doing work), and Unauthorized Work (Failure to obtain an Application to Construct or Replace a STS prior to doing work).

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District finds that the Director of the Water Quality Division did notify all entities that would be affected by the revisions to the Sewage Treatment System (STS) fees for **Application to Construct or Replace an STS, Permit to Install(PTI) an STS, Subdivision Review/Lot Evaluations, Additions, Installation Reinspection Fees, Sewage Truck Inspections, STS Installer Registration, STS Service Provider Registration, STS Septage Hauler Registration, STS Variances, STS Alteration Permit, and Unauthorized Work (Failure to obtain a PTI prior to doing work), Unauthorized Work (Failure to obtain an Alteration Permit prior to doing work), and Unauthorized Work (Failure to obtain an Application to Construct or Replace a STS prior to doing work)** at least thirty (30) days prior to establishing the fee pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3709.09 (C); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District hereby declares that it adopts the following revised Sewage Treatment System (STS) fee schedule for **Application to Construct or Replace an STS, Permit to Install(PTI) an STS, Subdivision Review/Lot Evaluations, Additions, Installation Reinspection Fees, Sewage Truck Inspections, STS Installer Registration, STS Service Provider Registration, STS Septage Hauler Registration, STS Variances, STS Alteration Permit, and Unauthorized Work (Failure to obtain a PTI prior to doing work), Unauthorized Work (Failure to obtain an Alteration Permit prior to doing work), and Unauthorized Work (Failure to obtain an Application to Construct or Replace a STS prior to doing work)** to become effective June 1, 2007.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any previous regulation, rule, or policy adopted by the Board of Health



of the Hamilton County General Health District, that in any way conflicts with this regulation in part or in whole, is hereby rescinded and repealed in part or in whole to the extent of any conflict; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District hereby finds by a vote of at least three-fourths of its members that this regulation be read only once, and the requirement that it be read on three different days be dispensed with as provided by law; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by this Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District, that this regulation be published in one newspaper of general circulation within the Hamilton County General Health District once a week for two consecutive weeks and that the first publication take place no later than ten (10) days prior to the effective date of the Regulation; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District find and determine that all formal actions relative to the passage of this regulation were taken in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirement, including Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
