**REGULATION ADOPTING REVISED LOCAL FEES FOR
PUBLIC SWIMMING POOLS AND SPAS**

The Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District met in a regular session on September 6, 2022, with the following members present:

Tracey Puthoff moved for adoption of the following regulation:

Regulation 2-2022, Adopting Revised Local Fees Pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Section 3709.09, 3709.21, and 3749.04 for Public Swimming Pools and Spas.

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District has the authority pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapters 3709.09, 3709.21, and 3749.04 to establish a uniform system of fee services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District is mandated to provide services that protect the public health and prevent disease; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District has determined that it is necessary to revise the local license fees for public swimming pools and public spas; pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 3749, Ohio Administrative Code, Chapter 3701-31; and

WHEREAS, any entity that would be affected by the revision to the fees for public swimming pools and spas were advised by the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District at least twenty (20) days prior to the September 6, 2022 hearing; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District hereby adopts Regulation 2-2022, revising the local fee schedule as follows for all public swimming pools and spas, effective January 1, 2023:

Individual Public Swimming Pools, Spas, and Special use Pools	\$388.00
Additional Public Swimming Pools, Spas, and Special Use Pools	\$258.00

State Fees In addition to the local fee for a license, a state fee portion, pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code, will be added.

Late Fees Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 3709.09(D) if a payment of a fee is not received by the day on which payment is due, the board of health shall assess a penalty pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District hereby finds by a vote of at least three-fourths of its members that this regulation be read only once and the requirement that it be read on three different days be dispensed with as provided by law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any previous regulation, rule, or policy adopted by the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District, that in any way conflicts with this regulation in part or in whole, is hereby rescinded and repealed in part or in whole to the extent of any conflict; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District, that this regulation be published in one newspaper of general circulation within the Hamilton County General Health District once a week for two consecutive weeks and that the first publication take place no later than ten (10) days prior to the effective date of the Regulation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District find and determine that all formal actions relative to the passage of this regulation were taken in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirement, including Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.




