Regulation 1-2014, Amending Hamilton County General Health District Sewage Code Regulation 529-- Sections 529.01(FF), 529.02(N)(1), 529.02(N)(7), 529.02(S), 529.18(E) and Table 1 pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapters 3707, 3709, and 3718

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District has the authority pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapters 3707, 3709, and 3718 to make such Orders and Regulations as are necessary for its own government, for the public health, the prevention or restriction of disease, and the prevention abatement and suppression of nuisances; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District is mandated to adopt such rules and regulations as it deems necessary for the public health, the prevention or restriction of disease, and the prevention, abatement and suppression of nuisances; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District has determined the need to amend Sewage Code Regulation 529, which regulates sewage treatment systems in order to prevent disease, contamination, and public health nuisances; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District has considered and documented the economic impact of revising and updating Sewage Code Regulation 529 on property owners pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Section 3718.02(B)(1); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District has considered available technologies and the nature and economics of the available alternatives in amending Sections 529.01(FF), 529.02(N)(1), 529.02(N)(7), 529.02(S), 529.18(E) and Table 1 of Sewage Code Regulation 529; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District hereby adopts Regulation 1-2014, Amending Hamilton County General Health District Sewage Code Regulation 529- Sections 529.01(FF), 529.02(N)(1), 529.02(N)(7), 529.02(S), 529.18(E) and Table 1 attached hereto and that it becomes part of the record of the local Regulations of the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Hamilton County General Health District, Sewage Code Regulation 529 amendments as adopted per Regulation 1-2014 are effective on March 17, 2014; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any previous regulation, rule, or policy adopted by the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District, that in any way conflicts with this regulation in part or in whole, is hereby rescinded and repealed in part or in whole to the extent of any conflict; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District hereby finds by a vote of at least three-fourths of its members that this regulation be read only once and the requirement that it be read on three different days be dispensed with as provided by law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District, that this regulation be published in one newspaper of general circulation within the Hamilton County General Health District once a week for two consecutive weeks and that the first publication take place no later than ten (10) days prior to the effective date of the Regulation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District find and determine that all formal actions relative to the passage of this regulation were taken in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirement, including Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
