WHEREAS, the goal of this initiative is to provide addiction and recovery support to Hamilton County businesses and their staff; and

WHEREAS, the Health Commissioner is recommending endorsement of the Recovery Friendly Hamilton County initiative as created by Hamilton County Public Health; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District hereby approves the adoption of the Recovery Friendly Hamilton County initiative; and
