WHEREAS, the Finance Officer has confirmed by evidence of their signature on the usage document that they are solely responsible for the credit card and its usage; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Officer also understands the responsibilities as described in O.R.C. 301.27 and agrees to monitor the usage of the credit cards and promptly notify the Board of Health of any change(s) that needs to be made to the estimate. NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Health of Hamilton County, Ohio that Hamilton County Public Health is hereby authorized to use:
