**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the Tuberculosis (Tb) Control Restricted Fund/sub fund 998/018, organization code account 930224, to increase expense code 625 by \$2,500, expense code 630 by \$6,600, expense code 848 by \$20,000, expense code 910 \$28,976 and expense code 920 \$22,739 to provide disease prevention services to the community, and such additional costs are funded by a corresponding decrease in expense code 511 \$80,815;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Health of the Hamilton County General Health District authorizes an increase in budgeted appropriations of \$2,500 expense code 625, \$6,600 expense code 630, \$20,000 expense code 848, \$28,976 expense code 910 and \$22,739 expense code 920 and a decrease of \$80,815 expense code 511 in the Tb Control Restricted Fund/sub fund 998/018, organization code 930224, effective on July 10, 2017; and
