Facility clean and sanitary. Continue to strictly clean and disinfect tattoo procedure areas before and after each procedure. Utilize the disinfectant to clean all surfaces, including but not limited to tables, chairs, cabinets, etc. Ensure all tattooists training records are available at all times and up-to-date. Routinely self inspect tattoo inks for expirations and discard if expired. Client records complete.
